# **Lasallian Facilitation**

A program for those who contribute, or would like to contribute to the Lasallian dimension of their workplace

### **Aims**

- 1. To develop the capacity of school and other personnel who lead Lasallian formation in their own workplaces.
- 2. To provide and demonstrate resources for use in the four areas of Lasallian formation.
- 3. To develop ways in which leaders might use the resources in their own workplaces.
- 4. To share resources and ideas contributed by participants.
- 5. To provide leaders with some intensive formation in selected aspects of the four areas of Lasallian formation.

## **Participants**

This program is designed for those who already contribute, or would like to contribute, to the Lasallian dimension of their school or workplace. It is not *solely* for those designated as Lasallian Facilitators – whose participation and experience will certainly be a major resource during the program.

### **Dates and Venue**

The formal program will begin promptly on **Monday 7 March at 8:30 am**, at the **Provincial Office**, 26 Meredith Street, Bankstown. The program will conclude with lunch on **Tuesday 8 March**. The Monday program will conclude at 5:30 pm.

Two hours have been allotted to each of the four related areas of Lasallian formation:

- the story of John Baptist de La Salle (1651-1719)
- the ongoing story in which we are the current 'actors' (1719-2016)
- Lasallian pedagogy
- Lasallian spirituality

This will involve some fairly concentrated work: eight hours over a day and a half.

#### **Content**

For each of these four areas, during the two allotted hours

- a resource will be provided and demonstrated, and its potential use discussed
- other resources indicated by participants will be shared and discussed
- there will be an 'intensive' on one particular aspect of the area, for the benefit of the participants' own ongoing formation

For example, the resource to be provided and demonstrated in the Story of the Founder area will include an illustrated 16-page A5 booklet, *John Baptist de La Salle: a short biography*. The 'intensive' in the Ongoing Story will concern the attitudes of the 18<sup>th</sup> century intelligentsia towards the education of the poor. The resources for Lasallian pedagogy will include Br Gerard Rummery's short film clip on the *Conduct of the Christian Schools*. In the Lasallian Spirituality 'intensive' De La Salle's approach to the ministry of teaching will be considered in relation to the influential 'French School' of spirituality on which he drew.

### **Limited numbers**

### Certification
